# Alaska: explore the ports

## Anchorage (Whittier)

Imagine meeting a moose or a bear up close at the Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center, or joining in Native song and dance at the Native Heritage Center. Anchorage combines spectacular wilderness and modern indulgences.



## Skagway

Imagine the excitement of gold panning, or marvelling at waterfalls, glaciers and vistas when you take the White Pass Scenic Railway, described as the 'scenic railway of the world'.



## Icy Strait Point

Indulge in a locally caught crab; ascend to the top of Hoonah Mountain and zipline over sweeping views of the rainforest - perhaps catching a glimpse of your ship. Here the rich, authentic culture of the Huna Tlingit people still endures.



## Juneau

Beautiful glaciers and thrilling outdoor activities are waiting for you in Juneau, a city made famous by its discovery of gold nuggets "as large as beans". Go whale watching or feel your heart race on a sled pulled by huskies.



## Ketchikan

Watch athletes vie for the title in axe throwing and log rolling at the Great Alaskan Lumberjack Show. Stroll the halls of Totem Heritage Center, or wander along historic Creek Street filled with quaint buildings and colourful galleries.



## Fairbanks

'The Golden Heart City' is famous for its historical and modern gold industries, so why not visit one of the region's many gold mines?



## Victoria, B.C.

Wander down a winding pathway of sparkling fountains and exquisite foliage within the floral wonderland of Butchart Gardens. Victoria has a distinctly British flair.



## Vancouver, B.C.
